- 5. DISCUSSION
 - a. Presentation on the Financial Reports for September 2024, *Presented by the Finance Director.*The Finance Director reported a current \$15,000 shortfall from the projected budget but noted pending funds, including Small City Assistance are still unaccounted for in these reports. He provided updates on departmental budgets, highlighting changes in payroll, conference registrations, and per diem costs since the last workshop. There was discussion around fireworks fees, with concerns that fees are only collected from permanent businesses like Diablos, and not from temporary vendors. A solution is being explored to enforce fee collection from all vendors. Trustee Herrera raised concerns about the municipal judge's pay and suggested looking into it to avoid any potential litigation. Suggested reallocating unused Police Department funds to the general fund, potentially for street repairs. Mayor Murillo also mentioned potential equipment acquisitions to support year-round street maintenance by public works. The city has spent approximately \$1.3 million while generating \$1.2 million, resulting in a \$134,380 deficit. This deficit is considered typical for this point in the fiscal year, with expectations for improvement closer to February.
